





INTRODUCTION

We are pleased that you are considering AE Tuition to accelerate your child's education. For over 35 years, AE Tuition has been preparing children for success in the classroom, 11+ exams, and beyond. Our approach provides children with the structure and techniques needed to build their knowledge, to expand their thinking skills, and to be creative. We believe that learning precedes doing—you can't do without first learning.

AE Tuition was established by Dr Stephen Curran, who has decades of experience as a qualified teacher, initially teaching at primary and secondary schools in South East England and at university level. Frustrated with the educational system and seeing children lagging behind, Stephen began tutoring children in the early 1990s to bridge the gap between state school education and what was necessary for passing 11+ exams. AE Tuition started with only a few pupils, but now educates between 2,000 and 2,500 pupils annually through three tuition centres (Langley, Slough, and Feltham), and remotely online and through state-of-the-art production and filming, across the UK and globally.

Dr Stephen Curran's dedication to education extends further; Stephen and his teaching team create all the materials for the Tuition Centres. In the late 1990s, Stephen founded another venture, AE Publications, to publish and sell books for children from Year 3 to Year 7 for Key Stage 2 and 11+ preparation.

Beyond AE Tuition and AE
Publications, in 2005, the UK
Government and opposition invited
Stephen to join an educational
consortium to share his insights on
enhancing the education system.
When Nick Gibb became Minister of
State for Schools, he asked Stephen
to join the panel to discuss revisions
to the maths national curriculum.
The new maths curriculum, which
mandates that all children know their
times tables by Year 4, was introduced
in 2014.

Stephen's passion and commitment to improving education continues as he collaborates with news broadcasters and other media outlets to advocate for further changes in the educational system.



METHODOLOGY

The AE Tuition methodology for educational success has been developed from experience we have gained over more than 35 years. Our tuition methodology produces significant changes in a child's educational progress, and very high 11+ pass rates.

It doesn't matter if you enrol your child on a classroom or remote course, the same methodology is followed across all our courses.

AE Tuition prepares children for any grammar school exam in England. Our courses will prepare your child to sit 11+ exams for verbal reasoning, non-verbal reasoning, maths, English and critical thinking skills. We also run 11+ English and maths courses for grammar schools that only require these two subject areas.

The preparation covers everything necessary for GL Assessment (Granada Learning) and equivalent 11+ examinations. It is also excellent preparation for verbal reasoning, mathematics and English examinations in the independent sector.

Preparation consists of the following disciplines:

✓ Verbal Reasoning

Verbal reasoning skills are developed using AE Tuition workbooks and testbooks. We also use some selected test materials from other reputable publishers.

✓ Non-verbal Reasoning

Non-verbal reasoning techniques are taught utilising AE tuition workbooks and testbooks and some carefully selected test materials from other established publishers.

✓ Maths

This involves developing a child's mathematical ability above national standard in the National Curriculum. The AE Tuition series of Maths workbooks is highly successful in enabling children to reach their potential. AE Tuition testbooks are used to hone children's skills.

English

Our courses focus on the development of comprehension, grammar, punctuation, syntax, spelling and vocabulary and creative writing skills. This also helps children improve their scores in verbal reasoning as well as English exam papers. English is often an area of weakness for many children, and for this reason we have increased the emphasis on this

work to ensure children build a firm foundation. AE Tuition materials form the basis of everything that is taught. This is supported by other suitable materials from reputable publishers.

Critical Thinking

The courses are designed to help children think critically and specific practice in these skills is provided through our specialised workbooks.

✓ Weekly Test Scores

AE Tuition class tests are used on a weekly basis as a means of measuring children's progress and reinforcing their understanding and technique.

✓ Mock Examinations

These give children a chance to practise GL Assessment-style practice papers comprising verbal reasoning, English, mathematics and non-verbal reasoning under exam conditions.

Mock exams are marked by an OMR reader just like the real exams. All mock exams include follow up by a teacher and areas of weakness are indicated on reports.

OUR TUITION CENTRES

Our tuition centres are located in Langley, Slough and Feltham. Each centre follows the same teaching methodology that has produced success over many years – information is relayed, technique is taught, and material is mastered. This process leads children to become free-thinking, independent learners. This same standard applies whether a course is delivered face-to-face in all our centres, or via remote learning based in our Slough centre.

Each class is taught by an experienced, UK-qualified teacher who has undergone advanced training in delivering AE Tuition specialised programmes. Their one objective is to help every child exceed national standards and achieve exam success. Each teacher is supported by a dedicated team of supervisors and classroom assistants. The number of support team is determined by the pupil ratio. The classroom assistants handle routine administrative tasks and provide one-to-one support to the pupils.

Supervisors and assistants wear colour coded shirts determined by seniority and role for ease of identification.

All AE Tuition staff are DBS checked and adhere to our stringent standards to ensure educational excellence, both in our tuition centres and through remote learning.

REMOTE LEARNING COURSES

With over 35 years of experience in delivering our courses, our reputation has spread across the UK and internationally. Our tuition is designed not only for those in close vicinity to our tuition centres, but it is also supporting children remotely on a nationwide basis to achieve 11+ success in state grammar schools and the independent sector. We are also working with a growing number of children abroad who are preparing for education in the UK.

Pupils enrolled in our remote learning courses receive the same quality tuition and support as those in our classrooms. Our courses equip children for GL Assessment and other equivalent 11+ exams set by grammar schools in England and Northern Ireland as well as independent school exams.

Remote learning tuition is delivered via Zoom sessions from our Slough tuition centre by a dedicated and experienced class teacher, supported by supervisors and trained assistants. Tuition is 'live' and involves whole class teaching by the teacher, combined with one-to-one support on areas of difficulty. Professionally pre-recorded sessions for 11+ courses are also provided for additional






















AE PUBLICATIONS RANGE

The weekly sessions were structured and very engaging. The teachers were approachable and made time to explain difficult concepts. Classroom assistants were always on hand to offer guidance, ensuring no one felt left behind. Their encouragement motivated me to push through any struggles I faced.

I particularly enjoyed the timed exercises with tests every week, which helped me manage my exam anxiety. A minor downside was the intensity of the sessions and homework, as it sometimes felt a lot to balance with school work, but I devised a routine to keep me on track.

My teacher was great at motivating us. A fond memory I have is of a game we played of who could earn the most stickers for good work. This was so much fun to play with the other children in my group and helped me to get to know them.

WHAT I FOUND CHALLENGING

The homework was challenging but effective. It reinforced what I had learned in class and allowed me to identify and address my weaker areas. My parents found the homework structure clear and appreciated the progress reports provided by the tuition centre, which kept them updated on my development.

MY EXPERIENCE OF TAKING THE 11+ EXAMS

When it was time for the exams, the initial feeling was anxiety, but with AE Tuition I felt prepared and confident. Through our experience of my daughter's time at primary school, the preparation for the 11+ exams is often the first step change in a child's life. The exams for the Tiffin and HBS schools were challenging and, for Slough schools, they were time sensitive.
